

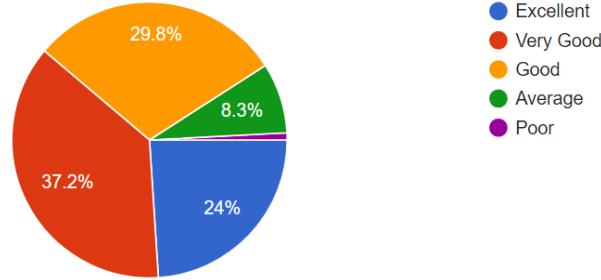

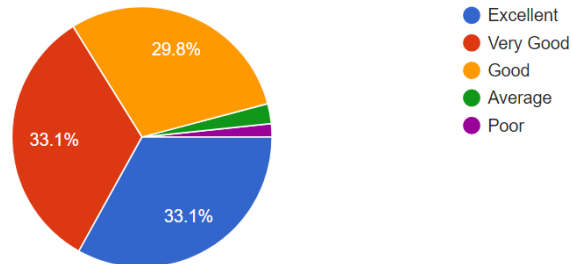

Approx. 61% of students rate the international recognition of available textbooks and reference books as very good or excellent, 29 % percentage of students are just satisfied and only 10 % of students says that the collection of these books needs improvement.

Action Taken:

Every year, many new textbooks and reference books suggested by subject experts have been added for various subjects to the rich collection of the library.

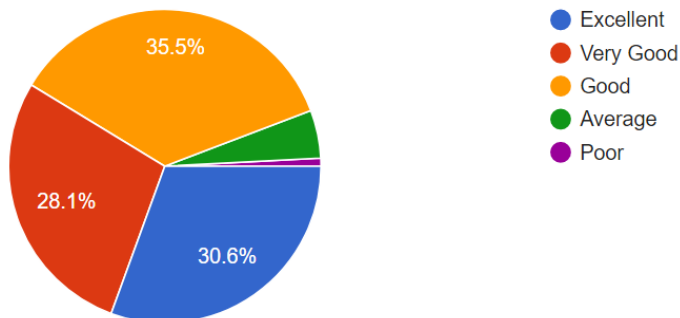

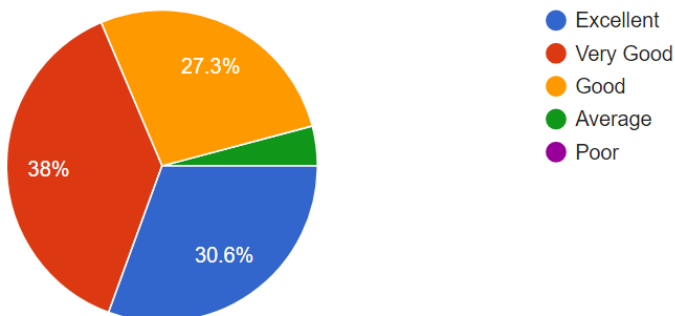

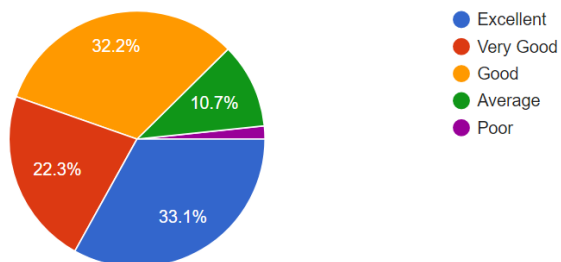

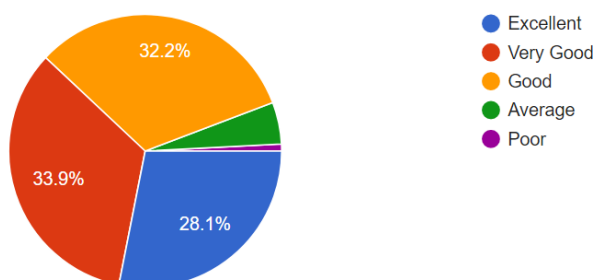

Action Taken:

Along with regular syllabus teaching, Students' Start Up and Innovation projects, Finishing School projects are implemented by the college to enhance the real-life learning experience of the students.

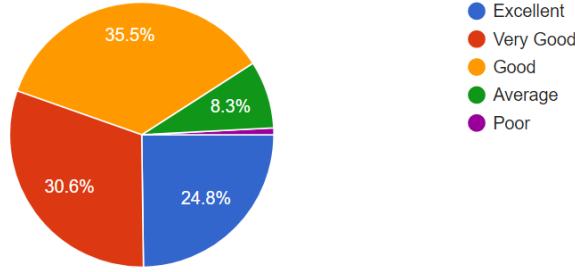

Due to Skill-based learning, entrepreneurship trainings and workshops, Hands-on Practice training and workshops, Instrumentation Training-workshops, industrial visits-trainings and internships etc along with regular teaching and learning through ICT tools makes the college education useful and relevant to present job.

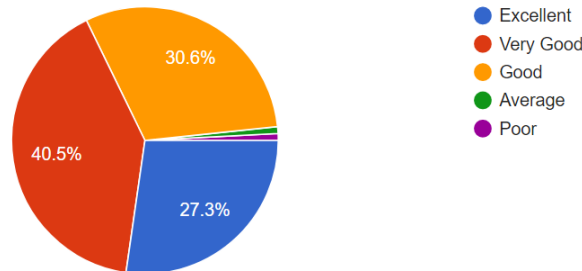

Approx. 55 % of students rate the syllabus address to cross cutting issues such as environment, gender and human rights very good or excellent, 36 % percentage of students are just satisfied and 9 % students say that the syllabus address to cross cutting issues such as environment, gender and human rights needs improvement.

Action Taken:

By implementation various University Elective Generic Papers to address the Cross-cutting issues such as environment, gender and human rights. Along with this, through various co curricular and extra-curricular activities and competitions organized under NSS, NCC, Sarva Netrutva Project implemented by the Trust, and the seven Bands of Sapta-Dhara, Sapta-Dhara an initiative of Govt. of Gujarat, the college sensitizes students towards these cross cutting issues of environment, gender and human rights.

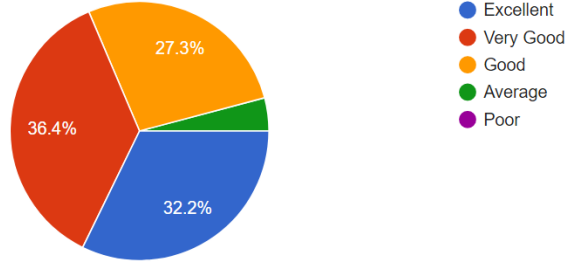

Approx. 68 % of students rate the curriculum facilities available in their college are helpful for developing soft skills very good or excellent, 31 % percentage of students are just satisfied and rest of students, 1% says that the curriculum facilities available in their college are helpful for developing soft skills needs improvement.

Action Taken:

The college has developed two Computer Laboratories for Mathematical Software Teaching, a Language Laboratory for SCOPE, a Govt. of Gujarat initiative for English Language Proficiency through four Soft Skills Teaching etc. to create employability among students.

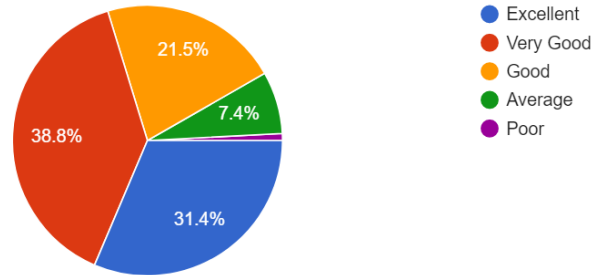

Through their active participation in various University Statutory Bodies like Board of Studies, Academic Council, Executive Council, Senate etc., they try to design the curriculum with experiential and application-oriented learning methodology. So, Students can learn to apply their knowledge and experience to real-life situations, making them ready to handle whatever life poses for them.

The college has Central Research Laboratory and Macro-micro Soil Testing Laboratory, Advanced Plant Tissue Culture Laboratory along with traditional departmental laboratories which have been opened for all the alumni students for their research and project works.
